#### **Events**

Hosting gatherings like galas, auctions, walks, and golf tournaments where participants engage in activities to raise funds and awareness for a cause.



#### Face-to-Face Meetings

Personal meetings with potential donors to discuss the nonprofit's mission, needs, and impact, fostering deeper connections and trust.



#### **Corporate Partnerships**

Collaborating with businesses for funding, sponsorships, or in-kind donations, aligning corporate social responsibility goals with the nonprofit's mission.



#### Peer-to-Peer (P2P) Fundraising

Encouraging supporters to raise funds through their personal networks, often via events like walks, runs, or online campaigns.

#### **Board Giving**
